## Interactive Divorce Forms Now Available for Travis County Residents

Austin, TX – December, 18, 2014 – Travis County District Clerk Amalia Rodriguez-Mendoza announced today her office can now accept uncontested divorce filings prepared electronically via *TurboCourt*<sup>TM</sup>, the newest e-filing service provider for Texas courts. Currently, this application is only available for filing in the Travis County District Courts and will soon be available throughout the state of Texas.

Designed for self-represented litigants but also available for use by attorneys, *TurboCourt*<sup>™</sup> functions much like online income tax form preparation, using a set of interview questions to quickly and easily prepare the necessary filings utilizing Texas Supreme Court approved forms. *TurboCourt*<sup>™</sup> customizes the required forms based on the information provided by the filer, resulting in a professional looking court filing. Once prepared, the filings can be instantly submitted using e-filing. The forms are available any time of day or night from the convenience of the home, library, office or any device with Internet access.
